## **Personality Development :**

Apart from academics, the school lays special emphasis on various games and sports and co-curricular activities and students are encouraged to take part in inter-house and inter-school competitions. Under the Games and Sports Programme - different Athletic events like Various Races Throws, Jumps, Badminton, Table Tennis, Kho-Kho, Volley Ball etc., are covered. ## WITHDRAWAL

Students can be asked to leave the school or dismissed from the school on the following grounds.

- ➡ Indiscipline.
- ➡ Unsatisfactory progress in academics.
- ➡ On repeating the same class for two years.
- ➡ Non-Payment of school fee.





### **School Transport :**

The excellent transport facility is available on scheduled routes for the students. Approximate timing for each bus stop on various routes of our buses is given in the route chart. The routes and stops are ascertained on the basis of convenience to parents and their wards and they are subject to change from time to time on the basis on change in fuel prices.

### **Educational Tours and Excursions :**

Adventurous activities are a part of school curriculum. Students are sent for educational and recreational excursions, Picnics, Museums, Art Galleries, Temples etc.

### **Competitive Exams :**

Students are encouraged to appear in the nationally reputed competitive exams like Science and Maths & Eng. Olympiads, Talent Search Exams etc at their cost.

### **Parent - Teachers' Meeting :**

Parent - Teachers' meetings are conducted periodically. These meetings are intended to review the pupil's performance in the presence of parents, Students and subject teachers. The meetings should help to sort out all matters on merit in a spirit of harmony in consonance with the CVIS philosophy of "Vasudeva Kutumbakam". The cordial and mutual discussions between parents and Teachers / Principal should ultimately help students to improve their performance with collective effort of the school and parents. Suggestions from both ends are welcome to implement new programmes towards improvement in academic standards, cultural and moral values, sports and other activities.

## Procedure for Admissions :

- Admission procedure is based on the guidelines of CBSE. Admissions are open on availability of vacancies.
- Registration for Admission into Class VI, usually opens in the month of February/ March.
- Registration form will be supplied from the School Accounts Office along with School Prospectus on payment. Parent / Guardian must fill in the registration form and necessary papers with utmost care and submit the same in the school office, and obtain acknowledgment with application / registration number.
- Mere registration does not guarantee admission.
- Admission list will be displayed only in the school notice board and no letters will be sent to parents.

**ADMISSION will be confirmed only on submission of:**

- **Admission Form :** (to be supplied by the school office)
- Submission of Transfer Certificate / Record sheet from recognized school.
- Payment of prescribed fee by stipulated date. Any other if prescribed specifically.

## Transfer Certificate :

- Any parent intends to take Transfer certificate in the middle of academic year should submit a written application in advance of months fee in lieu thereof; Any parent intends to withdraw his/her ward at the end of the academic year, should submit a written application in the month of March/April only for collecting the TC immediately after the annual results are declared.
- In all cases, NO DUES Certificate should be submitted along with the application for issue of Transfer Certificate.
- The school on valid reasons issues bonafide / study certificate to any student on submission of written application from parents.

## Change in Date of Birth (DOB):

Once recorded in the school scholar register, change in the date of birth will not normally be accepted, except where over whelming documentary evidence exists and where a genuine mistake has been committed.





## General Instructions to the Parents :

1. All entries in the diary from the school must be shown to parents and entries made by the parents should be brought to the notice of the relevant school staff.

### CONDUCT AND DISCIPLINE :

1. Strict discipline must be maintained within the school premises.
2. Students must not litter the school premises. They must keep their classrooms, corridors and campus as clean as possible and throw leftovers in to the dustbins only.
3. Students must respect the school property. Damage done even by accident must be reported at once by the one who causes it.
4. Students are expected to be courteous at all times.
5. Students must carry text books, exercise books and stationary according to the time table.
6. Students' cycles must be locked and parked in the cycle stand.
7. Students are not allowed to drive scooters/mopeds/cars while commuting to and from the school.
8. Every student must carry a tiffin box, a table mat, a clean napkin and a handkerchief every day. Students must have the refreshment in the break time only.
9. Non vegetarian food is strictly prohibited in the school campus.
10. Playing with colour or bursting of crackers within the school premises and school buses is prohibited.
11. Elaborate birthday celebrations are not allowed in the school.
12. Mobile phone, I-pods etc are prohibited in the school, If a student is found carrying any of these, it will be confiscated immediately.
13. Students must speak in English in the school campus.
14. The School reserves the right to dismiss a student whose conduct is unbecoming and unsuitable to the school. Immorality, grave insubordination, contempt of authority or willful damage to property can lead to suspension/expulsion from the school.
15. No student is allowed to wear hair colour, mehendi or nail polish.
16. School will not be responsible for any incident that takes place outside school premises.
17. Child should ensure his security himself, If he is commuting by his own vehicle.
18. School will provide the Transport facility on the wish of the parent only.
19. Names of fee defaulters for two months will be struck off. Hence they will have to seek re-admission.

## **PUNCTUALITY AND ATTENDANCE :**

1. Attendance is compulsory on the first and last working day of every term.
2. Student must report to school on time.
3. School gates are closed ten minutes after the bell.
4. Students are marked late in the late record in the school diary.
5. Regular attendance is most essential.
6. The minimum requirement of attendance is 90%.
7. Parent should fill the leave record for each day the student is absent from school stating the reason for absence.
8. No student who has been absent on the previous day will be admitted to the class without the filled leave record signed by concerned parents.
9. Student who has been sick should bring a medical certificate from registered Doctor before joining school.
10. A Student returning to school after suffering from an infectious or contagious disease should produce a fitness certificate issued by a Doctor, permitting him / her to attend the school.
11. Students are not allowed to go home once they come to school in the morning. Appointment with doctors or any social engagements must not be arranged during school hours.
12. Repeated absence without leave or unexplained absence for more than 3 consecutive days renders the student liable to have his/her name struck off the rolls. Re-admission may be granted only after payment of a re-admission fee at the discretion of the Principal.

## **School Uniform:**

- School Uniform encourages Simplicity, Cleanliness, Brotherhood, Discipline, Mannerism, Feeling of equality and a sense of awareness among them. Every fine? expulsion can be imposed.
- White Shirt (full sleeves), Black Trousers for all classes, Black Socks, Black Leather Shoes, Identity Card, School Badge & Belt.
- On wednesday & Saturday : T-Shirt/Track Suit, White Canvass Shoes & White Socks.
- Black Blazer for class Nur to XI.





## **We entreat the parents / Guardians with the following recommendation**

- Proper development of a child depends mainly on two factors - your supervision at home and ours at school. If either is lacking, the progress of your ward suffers. We expect you to co-operate with the school authorities in enforcing regularity, discipline and habit to study and prepare lessons with keen interest among your wards.
- Student's home-work diary must be checked and signed daily. It is an important medium of communication between you and the teachers. You are required to notify the school of any change in the address immediately.
- You are required to acquaint yourself thoroughly with the rules and regulations of the school as well as other details and to maintain cordial relations with the school staff.
- Students must not be disturbed in course of studies during school hours by the parents / guardians / relatives. Parent - Teacher meeting is the proper event for holding discussions. However, in case of any incident, prior permission of the Principal is necessary.
- Tutition by our teachers is specifically prohibited. Students who want to improve, in case they are not making satisfactory progress, can avail the facility of remedial and extra classes conducted by our teachers absolutely free of without any charge.
- Bulk SMS facility has been extended to each student. The parents shall regularly be informed about child's regularity and performance in the school.
- It should always be kept in mind that we are all linked together in a continuous progress of educating the children. Hence cordial relations must be maintained at all levels, realizing that the net result of recriminations falls on the child.
